

THE PROPOSED LANDSCAPE TREATMENT

The landscape proposals have been produced to create an excellent landscape infrastructure for the proposed housing that promotes the ecological attributes of the site. Proposed tree, hedge and shrub planting have been chosen so that they are suitable for garden environments but offer a wide range of bio-diversity benefits. These include, flowering plants for bees, butterflies, large native trees and fruiting trees for nesting birds. Single and mixed specie hedgerows are proposed along property boundaries providing a diverse habitat for a range of fauna and flora.

The existing native hedgerows that bound the sites perimeter will be retained and gapped up where needed. It is suggested, that those properties that have existing hedgerows within their gardens have a management agreement attached that will restrict the removal of these hedgerows. This will ensure that the ecological value and habitat that these hedges offer is retained and not lost.

The existing wildlife pond it to be improved and made accessible to the public.
